Questions for discussion:

##### **1. Verses 31-32**

- a. What tempts us not to believe verse 31 which tells us that God is for us?
- b. Who is God for?
- c. What evidence shows us that God is for us?

##### **2. Verses 33-37**

- a. How are Christians secure from every charge and all condemnation against them?
- b. What does it mean to be more than conquerors through Christ?
- c. How are Christians more than conquerors?

##### **3. Verses 38-39**

- a. Are you convinced that nothing can ever separate you from God's love?
- b. What do you allow in your life that separates you from the love of God? What are you going to do to change that?
